

# Govt school students gain insight on 'Digitisation'

The session covered important aspects like National Scholarship Portal, E-Hospital, Digilocker, E-sign framework, Swacchbharat

It also explained about the common service centre available

for them in their vicinity through which they can register for

many digital schemes and use them for their benefit. Around 70 students from class 11 and 12 of different streams participated in the event enthusiastically.

They were enlightened about how to store their valuable documents digitally on a government application, book their appointments and view medical reports online and understand the importance of E-sign framework through Aadhar card. New technological aspects like reporting cleanliness issues through Swacch Bharat mobile app, BHIM App, Bharat Net & Wi-Fi hotspot were covered.

Short videos were accompanied by explanation for clear understanding. Interaction with students showed the knowledge they gained of the topic discussed in between session and at end of the session. The initiative received encouraging feedback from the teachers as well.
