1. Resident Medical Officer: One Post (On Contract)

Educational Qualification: MBBS degree with one-year internship from a recognized Institute. A valid registration certificate of Medical Council of India / any of the state Medical Council.

Experience: Minimum 2 years of post-internship clinical experience in recognized Hospitals / Health Centre.

Upper Age Limit: 55 Years.
