IIM Raipur Kicks off Y20 Consultation Event with a Bang!

IIM Raipur commenced the Y20 consultation event at its campus with much enthusiasm and anticipation on a bright morning of 25th February 2023. The event aimed to gather young leaders from all over the world to exchange ideas and thoughts on topics that impact youth globally.

Prior to the start of the event, the guests were given a tour of the campus. Additionally, they were treated with millet-based breakfast, as a contribution to India's observance of the International Year of Millets 2023. Further, the registration process was completed and a session for introductions and socializing was conducted for the delegates. To inaugurate the event, the guests were welcomed at the magnanimous auditorium of the institute. The lighting of the lamp was done by Smt. Renuka Singh, Hon'ble MoS, Tribal Affairs, GoI, along with other esteemed guests.



Dr. Ram Kumar Kakani, the Director of IIM Raipur, delivered the welcome address, expressing his belief that the Y20 Consultation event is a powerful driver of global transformation. He highlighted the importance of coming together to address the challenges posed by terrorism, socialist groups, and societal feudalism. Governments have a critical role to play in striking a balance between upholding human rights and maintaining law and order. Inter-community dialogue is crucial to ensuring that peace and harmony prevail. He encouraged the participants to engage in active discussions and brainstorming sessions throughout the event, so that they could generate innovative solutions to the world's most pressing issues.

Smt. Renuka Singh, Hon'ble MoS, Tribal Affairs, GoI, the Guest of Honour, began her speech by emphasizing the importance of the Y20 Consultation event as an opportune moment to pay tribute to all the freedom fighters who secured India's independence and contributed to its progress. dialogues and forums.

Despite the difficulties that India has faced, the country has played a crucial role in promoting world peace since gaining independence. She cited examples of how conflict had been curbed in Jammu and Kashmir and Northeastern states, where the youth are thriving. She expressed optimism that the discussions in this consultation would aid in peace building and enable us to achieve the goal of "Vasudev Kutumbakam." Her address was followed by her felicitation and Vote of Thanks by Prof. Sanjeev Prashar.

A panel discussion on the subject of "Channelizing youth in conflict resolution," was conducted. According to Dr. Ajay Kumar Singh, Ex-CS, Assam, Bodoland peace negotiator, the young generation should follow the establishment of peace, uphold and preserve that. Dr Mohit Garg, IPS, SP, Balrampur, frontline LWE experience, said that gradual erosion of faith in the system and in the government can be observed in naxal conflicted areas. Trust can be earned through getting in touch with the younger generation belonging to these areas, having conversations with them, and planning activities for them to participate in, including educational, cultural, and athletic pursuits. Shri Mohd. Aijaz Asad, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Srinagar emphasized that acts of terrorism and violence stifle the aspirations of the youth. Shri Reinhard Baumgarten, Reputed journalist, international conflict zones, German, brought up the conflict in Sudan and suggested that love could serve as a foundation for lasting peace. Sushree Priyanka Bissa, Youth icon, Nehru Yuva Kendra, said that the discussion of wars also brings up the issues related to food, water, and resources, national security.

The second panel discussion on Experience Sharing Peace-making, Peacebuilding and Peacekeeping was moderated by Shri Rajat Bansal, IAS (DC, Balodabazar). The panelists of this session were Brig. Basant K Ponwar (Retd.), AVSM, VSM (Ex-Director, Counterterrorism and Jungle Warfare College), Shri Ratan Lal Dangi, IPS (Director, CG State Police Academy), Shri Rob York (Director, Regional Affairs, Pacific Forum, USA) and Dr Aditi Narayani (Track chair Y2O).

The third panel talk, overseen by Dr. Sarveshwar Narendra Bhure, IAS (DC Raipur), was focused on Building consensus among communities. The panel included Shri Nitesh Kumar Sahu, a young leader from Mungeli, Chhattisgarh; Dr. Philippe Eye be Awono, an assistant professor at Jean Moulin University; and Sushree Shwetha Karambelkar, a 2nd year PGP student from IIM Raipur. One of the significant speakers in this session was Shri B Markam, anex-naxalite, who later surrendered and brought peace and transformation in the communities. He shared that as a youth how he was misguided into believing violence was a solution to various problems in his area. However, he quickly realized based on real life experiences and astute observations that violence is not a solution and joined the mainstream.

Another session moderated by the first year PGP students of IIM Raipur was focused on Multiple perspectives on reconciliation. The speaker Dr Prem Singh Bogzi (Visiting Distinguished Professor, IIM Raipur) commented that reconciliation involves recognizing that past actions may not have been ideal or efficient, but it requires bringing about social, economic, and political transformations and establishing a shared vision for moving forward.

The most significant segment of the event, which was the 'Youth Dialogue' with Shri Anurag Singh Thakur, Hon'ble Union Minister, GOI began with a lot of excitement among the students. It was moderated by Prof. Sanjeev Prashar, Professor, Marketing, IIM Raipur. The minister began by commending the state of Chattisgarh for its progress and expressing pride in being among eager and imaginative individuals. He was impressed using traditional art in the logo of IIM Raipur and feeling at home in Chhattisgarh with its waterfalls, temples, and 44% forest cover.

The state is rich in minerals, forests, metals, and produces the famous Kosa silk. He highlighted the importance of technology in bridging gaps, providing opportunities to showcase talent, and solve global problems.

He praised the youth of Chattisgarh for leveraging disruptive technologies and possessing unmatched vigor, vitality, and vibrancy. He beamed with pride while stating that India is the 3rd largest startup ecosystem in the world with 107 unicorns. He highlighted that to attain sustainable conflict prevention and resolution young voices need to come forward on the platforms that society offers. Youth engagement on a large scale is necessary given the size of the youth population across the G20 countries. The audience raised many inquiries regarding the involvement of young people in politics, enhancing GDP, self empowerment, the contribution of international students to their home country etc. The main lesson learned from this session is that continuous learning and acquiring new skills can empower young people to participate in their nation's progress and promote peace. He further quoted, "Your network is your net worth." He motivated young individuals to expand their network and establish more connections with people as it could be beneficial for their future. Moreover, he suggested that the youth should travel as much as possible to gain extensive exposure and experiences. He concluded by quoting "You are the present; you are the hope of the world."

In conclusion, the Y20 Consultation event organized by IIM Raipur was a resounding success, bringing together young leaders, experts, and policymakers to exchange ideas and develop innovative solutions for building peaceful and sustainable communities. The panel discussions, keynote addresses, and youth dialogue sessions explored various perspectives on community building, consensus-building, and reconciliation, underscoring the need for collaborative and inclusive approaches to address complex societal challenges. The event's success underscores IIM Raipur's commitment to fostering leadership and promoting sustainable development and building momentum on this in the future.

Abstract: New venture creation is critical to sustain transgenerational family entrepreneurship. Business families with diversified businesses perceive emergent opportunities distinctly from those perceived by family firms engaged in a single line of business. Driven by passionate next-generation family champions, the scope of venture creation for business families goes beyond business, including creation of social ventures. This probe examines four in-depth case studies of new venture creation by four business families in India. The study probes the drivers, the process, key players, and the

dynamics of new venture creation by these business families. The study observes that the nature, intensity, and direction of the influence of family champions varies across business families, leading to different venture choices and outcomes. Interests and inclinations of next-generation members distinctly shapes business families' venture creation and resource allocation decisions. Some business families create new business ventures for strategic depth, competitive advantage, growth and providing career path to family members. In contrast, other business families create new social ventures for a lasting family legacy or to support a social cause espoused by the next-generation family champion. Based on the observations of their new venture creation decisions and strategies followed, business families are classified into two categories: the guarded Conservatives and the adventurous Pathfinders. The chapter presents a typology of new venture creation by business families and concludes with implications for theory and practice.

Abstract: This study aims to overview the existing literature, knowledge framework, and intellectual structure mapping in the field of corporate environmental performance (CEP) and corporate financial performance (CFP) by employing a bibliometric analysis approach to selected 311 papers sourced from the Scopus database between 1994 and 2022. It presents the publication growth, influential sources, productive authors, and collaboration index of countries using Biblioshiny software. Stringent regulatory regime and stakeholders' pressure followed by a growing trend of

publication motivated us to comprehend the evolving facets of the relationship using co-citation analysis followed by a systematic literature review using coupling analysis which identified five research themes as CEP–CFP relationships—facets, strategies and dimensions, and methodological choices during the initial phase of 1994–2014; and green innovation and corporate sustainability practices, environmental disclosure and environmental responsibility, and green development behaviour and practices during 2015–2022. From the insights congregated from research themes, the study discusses prominent developments and provides future research directions to further enrich the field of CEP and CFP. Our findings provide various global regulatory frameworks, government, policymakers, and firm managers the need to explore the dynamic factors while formulating the strategic environmental policy and how it contributes to the financial performance of the firms.

The valedictory function marked the end of the MDP on the evening of Thursday, February 9, 2023. The valedictory function was virtually attended by the ICAI representatives.






