The broad areas of the workshop shall include systems science, systems diagnosis, systems dynamics, science of regenerative ness, and illustrations of regenerative systems.

The workshop has been designed to enhance the systems design thinking competence of the participants who could incorporate them to better diagnose complexities, interdependence of actors and factors, imbibe the regenerative values to better align knowledge, skills, values and systems consciousness to enable oneself and others around to be **effective, sustainable, and regenerative** within one's own system-entity and at different levels of a larger ecosystem.

Objectives

The key objectives of the program are as follows:

- Be able to appreciate the significance of others in one's daily experiences and the reality of non-duality of things around us, whether in personal or professional spaces.
- Be able to understand the inherent nature of our interconnectedness, interdependence, interactions, and intent in our artificial human design of systems & natural ecosystems.
- Get some insights into methods of knowing in terms of analysis and synthesis and be to develop a multi-disciplinary systems thinking perspective.
- Be able to incorporate systems thinking and systems design in teaching and training corporate executives and development officials.
- Overall, be able to facilitate systems & ecosystems to transit from unitary high transaction cost with partial efficiency paradigm to a system-wide holistic regenerative paradigm.

Dr. Amar KJR Nayak is a Professor of Strategic Management at the Xavier Institute of Management, Xavier University Bhubaneswar. He has been the NABARD Chair Professor for two terms and now the Chairperson of the Centre for Sustainable Ecological Systems at XIMB < <https://xub.edu.in/cses/>> Prof. Nayak has been engaged in research, teaching, and policy advice on transition strategies for rebuilding sustainable ecological systems for the last about 20 years with the support of various national and international bodies.



His research on sustainable ecological systems includes the dimensions of organizations, institutions, production, governance, ecology and relationships from a design and systems science perspective. He uses multiple methodologies of research with an emphasis on Action Research in rural community systems. He has published five books, five monographs, several policy documents and over 80 research articles and cases.

He teaches and trains graduate students, doctoral scholars, development professionals, senior bureaucrats and policy executives on Research Methodologies, Competitive Strategies, Non-Competitive Strategies, Leadership and Transition Strategies for Sustainable Ecological Systems from the Design for “All Interacting Systems Dynamics: Perspective”. He has been an advisor to various organizations and institutions such as Government of India, various State Governments, FAO-UN, UNDP, World Bank, NABARD, BIRD, NIAM, DMI, Corporations, Foundations, and Not for Profit Organizations. He has widely travelled to and lived in different parts of the world including Asia, Europe, North America and South America for studies, lectures, seminars, and conferences.
