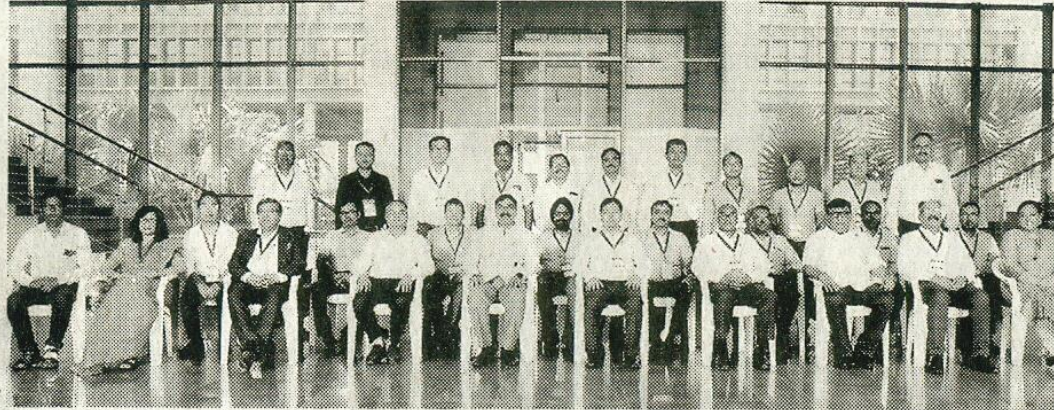


MDP on Academic Leadership Prog organised by IIM
