About the Programme

The Capacity Building Program on Academic Research Excellence for Young Faculty Members in Social Sciences is designed to empower and enhance the research capabilities of early-career academics in the field. This program aims to equip young faculty members with the necessary skills and knowledge to excel in their academic research endeavours and make significant contributions to the social sciences.

By engaging in this comprehensive capacity-building program, young faculty members in social sciences will be better equipped to pursue rigorous research projects, publish their work in reputable journals, and contribute significantly to the advancement of knowledge in their respective fields. Moreover, this program will facilitate the establishment of a vibrant academic community, fostering collaboration and elevating the overall research quality in the social sciences domain.

Key components of the program include:

- 1. Research Methodology Workshops: Specialized workshops focusing on various research methodologies commonly used in social sciences, including quantitative and qualitative research methods. Participants will learn how to design research studies, collect and analyse data, and interpret findings.
- 2. Publication and Writing Skills: Training sessions dedicated to improving academic writing skills, manuscript preparation, and the publication process. Young faculty members will receive guidance on structuring research papers, writing compelling abstracts, and navigating the publication submission process.
- 3. Grant Writing and Funding Opportunities: Sessions on writing successful research grant proposals to secure funding for research projects. Participants will be introduced to available funding opportunities in the social sciences and learn how to present their research ideas effectively to funding agencies.
- 4. Research Ethics and Integrity: Discussions on research ethics and integrity, emphasise the importance of conducting research responsibly, respecting participants' rights, and avoiding plagiarism or research misconduct.
- 5. Data Management and Analysis: Training on data management techniques and statistical analysis software commonly used in social sciences research. Participants will gain proficiency in handling and analysing research data to derive meaningful insights.
- 6. Networking and Collaboration: Opportunities for participants to network with established researchers, both within and outside their institution, fostering potential research collaborations and knowledge exchange.







Coverage

Broadly, the course intends to deal with a variety of analytical research methods used in social sciences and allied studies, with particular emphasis on the implementation of these methods. Topics to be covered include:

Eligibility criteria for participants

All those who are serving as a Lecturer/Assistant Professor/Young Faculty in the field of Social Sciences in a UGC-recognized Indian University/Deemed University/College/Institute of National Importance and ICSSR Research Institutes or engaged in or planning to engage in economic and social science research will be eligible to apply for the course.

People who are interested in undertaking research projects from the government and other funding agencies will also find it helpful.

The maximum number of participants is limited to 20. We encourage participation from within Chhattisgarh and all over India.

How to reach IIM Raipur

Raipur has good connectivity by Air, Rail, and Road.

By Air: All leading domestic airlines operate flights between Raipur and other major Indian cities (Ahmedabad, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Delhi, Hyderabad, Indore, Kolkata, Mumbai, and Vishakhapatnam). Distance from the Raipur Airport and IIM Campus is about 20 km.

By Rail: Many trains operate on the train route to Raipur daily, ensuring strong connectivity with all major cities in India. The distance from Raipur Central railway station to IIM Campus is about 30 km.

By Road: Raipur is linked by National and State highways. Raipur is connected by National Highway 6 (NH6) (connecting Mumbai-Calcutta) and by NH47 (connecting Visakhapatnam).

Both, the airport, and railway station lie near the city centre and leading hotels in Raipur.
