for handling economic and social issues at the micro and macro levels.

The objective is to involve inter-disciplinarity and provide direction to participants through all the stages of research—from identifying a viable research problem, data collection-questionnaire approach, focus group discussion- and evaluation of

the final report or quality research article. The application of methods will be illustrated using examples from diverse fields, including economics, behavioral studies, social issues related to education and health, and business. Hands-on sessions will be conducted using software like Microsoft Excel, SPSS, and R.
