Kiran, R., Kumar, P., & Bhasker, B. (2020). OSLCFit (Organic Simultaneous LSTM and CNN Fit): A Novel Deep Learning Based Solution for Sentiment Polarity Classification of Reviews. *Expert Systems with Applications*, 157.

Abstract: Review sentiment influences purchase decisions and indicates user satisfaction. Inferring the sentiment from reviews is an essential task in Natural Language Processing and has managerial implications for improving customer satisfaction and item quality. Traditional approaches to polarity classification use bag-of-words techniques and lexicons combined with machine learning. These approaches suffer from an inability to capture semantics and context. We propose a Deep Learning solution called OSLCFit (Organic Simultaneous LSTM and CNN Fit). In our architecture, we include all the components of a CNN until but not including the final fully connected layer and do the same in case of a bi-directional LSTM. The final fully connected layer in our architecture

consists of fixed length features from the CNN, and features for both variable length and temporal dependencies from the bi-directional LSTM. The solution fine-tunes Language Model embeddings for the specific task of polarity classification using transfer learning, enabling the capture of semantics and context. The key contribution of this paper is the combination of features from both a CNN and a bi-directional LSTM into a single architecture with a single optimizer. This combination forms an organic combination and uses embeddings fine-tuned to the reviews for the specific purpose of sentiment polarity classification. The solution is benchmarked on six different datasets such as SMS Spam, YouTube Spam, Large Movie Review Corpus, Stanford Sentiment Treebank, Amazon Cellphone & Accessories and Yelp, where it beats existing benchmarks and scales to large datasets. The source code is available for the purposes of reproducible research on GitHub.

Dhaggara, D., Goswami, M., & Kumar, G. (2020). Impact of Trust and Privacy Concerns on Technology Acceptance in Healthcare: An Indian Perspective. *International Journal of Medical Informatics*, 141.

Abstract: This paper augments the technology acceptance model (TAM) by empirically investigating the influence of behavioral traits (privacy concerns and trust) and cognitive beliefs (perceived usefulness and perceived ease of use) on patients' behavioral intention to accept technology in healthcare service delivery. Despite increased emphasis on healthcare service delivery, there has been limited studies as to how various behavioral constructs are related to adoption of new technology in healthcare sector. To this end, and to develop meaningful insights, a conceptual model integrating behavioral constructs with constructs related to technology acceptance model is devised. The aim here is essentially to understand relationships that predict patients' acceptance of technology in healthcare

services. The devised model is tested on responses obtained from survey of 416 patients availing healthcare service at various primary health centers in New Delhi, India. Structural equation modeling (SEM) is employed to conceptualize the model and validate nine hypotheses entailing key constructs. The results indicate that perceived usefulness, perceived ease of use, trust and privacy concern are direct predictors of patients' behavior to accept technology in availing healthcare services. In summary, this research provides an empirical contribution to the literature on effect of trust and privacy concerns on acceptance of technology in healthcare.

Kumar, S., & Das, S. (2020). Integrated framework of strategic orientation, value offerings and new venture performance. *Decision*. 47(1), 3-17.

Abstract: The paper provides an integrated framework to study new venture performance by integrating types of strategic orientation, competition and choice of value offerings of the new venture. The relationship between new venture performance, strategic orientation, value offerings and moderating role of competition is analyzed through structural equation modeling (SEM). The sample of 300 entrepreneurs/- founders of new ventures provides the necessary information to the model. The study found entrepreneurial orientation is more likely associated with the choice of new value offerings and has a higher impact on new venture performance in the presence of competition. The results indicate the strongest effect of new value offerings compared to incremental value offering on venture performance is useful for policy making at multiple levels of individual, regional and national start-ups policies.

Pandey, A. K., & Das, S. (2020). Exploring Adoption of E-Vehicles in India: An Institutional Perspective. Academy of Strategic Management Journal, 19(1), 1-10.

Abstract: eVehicle technology has been available in India for a decade, yet there has been less than appreciable production and adoption in the market. The possible reason for this is institutional void, which should not occur as there are several institutions to support it. We explore this phenomenon through qualitative study and find that despite the presence of institutions, failure of institutions occurs and are at times hidden due to external circumstances. This research maps the players and factors in the industry to illustrate this failure and define a model to better understand the business strategies adopted by firms in the presence of Institutional Voids. The future scope is suggested.

Shree, T., & Gupta, S. (2020, June 22-24). What Makes Online Groups and Pages Sustainable: An Examination Using Samaritan's Dilemma, PACIS 2020 Proceedings, Dubai. 33. https://aisel.aisnet.org/pacis2020/33

Abstract: Members and admins derive utility from online groups and pages in different ways. Since their utilities differ, any group related strategy to maximize their respective utility also varies. This tradeoff is more prominent in long run because groups must maximize utility to members and not only suffice admin's utility of group sustenance. This paper is an attempt in prescriptive diagnosis directed towards social media pages and group admins motivated to sustain their pages and groups through increased contribution of posts. We explore two dilemmas occurring due to tradeoffs between utilities of members and admin and also long-term and short-term utility goals in an online group. While addressing these tradeoffs, we simulate user's utility maximization behavior using generalized and non-contextual utility functions applicable across all online groups and pages. We mathematically confirm the applicability of Samaritan's dilemma in this context and draw strategic implications about the measures to resolve these dilemmas.


