IIM Raipur organised "Emerging Manager's Bootcamp"

Indian Institute of Management, Raipur organized a unique event "Emerging Manager's Bootcamp" module for the students of Post graduate programme 2024-26 batch. This event aimed to equip these students with foundational skills and knowledge necessary for their learning agility to enable academic and personal development, which include Self-Awareness, Working in Teams, Critical Thinking, Problem-Solving, Ethical Behaviour and Fortitude for Navigating Future Challenges. This Programme was a comprehensive seven days started from 24th to 30th July 2024.

The Morning sessions started with Physical Exercise, Yoga and Pranayama. After interaction with Director Sir and PGP Chairman a unique Bootcamp was organized in which all the students participated in the activities with utmost enthusiasm. Some of the key highlights of the programme include series of sessions/activities like PT, Yoga, Pranayama, Campus Tour, watching a movie, Sociogram, U Journaling (Problem Solving), Shape Career for Growth (Professional Development), Treasure Hunt, 777 Activity (Increase positive thinking, writing skills), Myers- Were included. Briggs Type Indicator (Tea, Building Exercise), Appraisal, Challenge and Support Activity, Kolb's LTM Inventory, Organizational Maze, Hollow Square, Emotional Intelligence Inventory, Situation-Behaviour-Influence Activity, Social Evils, 12 Angry Men, and 4 Chairs Activity.



For all 330 students, 10 groups were formed and named after 10 different colours each of the 30-35 students (with One Lead Facilitator and Co-Facilitator and dedicated staff), all the sessions were activity based and interactive orientated. The Facilitators were assigned to each group to conduct the session as per the scheduled timelines and carryout all the varied activities in their groups. Daily review meeting was conducted for the updates on the day session and next day's sessions to conduct the event smoothly.


