Do your homework, and when you see an opportunity, you really got to go for it".

Session 2nd was "Impact of Regulatory Changes on Indian Financial Markets and 3rd was "Role of fintech, digital finance, and AI in Transforming Indian Banking and Financial Landscape" respectively.

These products are manufactured and marketed as Chhattisgarh Herbals under the guidance of the Project Management Unit set up by IIM Raipur in collaboration with the CGMFP Federation. Chhattisgarh Herbals products have witnessed encouraging consumer acceptance, reflected in 600% growth in the last four years. Chhattisgarh Herbals is rapidly establishing itself as India's first FMCG brand based on Minor Forest Produce.

IIM Raipur Signs Historic MoU with Chhattisgarh Police to Combat Human Trafficking



The Indian Institute of Management Raipur (IIM Raipur) has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Chhattisgarh Police, which is an innovative and significant step towards combating human trafficking. IIM Raipur will conduct an in-depth study as part of this agreement to comprehend the underlying causes, socioeconomic effects, and rehabilitation requirements of victims of human trafficking. The study results will improve the efficacy of social intervention and law enforcement initiatives.

The important goals highlighted as a part of this MoU include determining the causes of Chhattisgarh's human trafficking, creating plans to stop survivors from becoming victims again, creating a strong policy to stop human trafficking, and assisting those who are impacted, especially women and children. These objectives emphasize the long-term sustainability of solutions, focusing on empowerment and reintegration.

The signing of the Memorandum of Understanding, which took place at the Chhattisgarh Police Headquarters, represents a significant advancement in the battle against human trafficking and reaffirms the state's dedication to social justice and human rights. It marks a pivotal moment in the collective effort to foster a safer, more equitable society and set a benchmark for future collaborations between academic institutions and law enforcement agencies.

IIM Raipur Announces Independent Admissions Process for MBA 2025-27 Batch, Exits CAP 2025
