Abstract: The present study examines the impact of sustainable transitions on the energy and environmental efficiency (EEE) of nations across the developed and developing world. It studies the temporal shift in the share of renewable sources in energy generation. It also analyses the change in the efficiency frontier of nations using data envelopment analysis (DEA). Further, it studies the macro-level drivers of EEE in the countries.

Design/methodology/approach– As the first step, we benchmark the EEE of the developed and developing nations using DEA. Subsequently, we look at the influence of institutional quality, human capital, R&D and knowledge systems on EEE, to develop a comprehensive understanding of the macro-level drivers of EEE. **Findings**– Our analyses reveal that a country’s institutional quality, human capital, and R&D are critical determinants of EEE. The results show that while human capital significantly impacts EEE, R&D expenditure alone has no substantial impact. The findings suggest that knowledge diffusion disperses best practices across nations and bridges EEE gaps. **Practical implications**– Attempts to promote sustainable energy transitions and improve EEE have met with varying levels of success. The results of this study will provide a useful guideline for the government to achieve the goal of EEE through sustainable energy transitions (SET). **Originality/value**– Unlike previous studies, we adopt a multi-factor EEE assessment. We also examine additional influences like the human capital of a nation and its knowledge management system to develop a comprehensive understanding of the macro-level drivers of EEE.

Abstract: This study examines the relationship between electronic participation (e-participation) and economic growth across different development contexts, with a specific focus on corruption as a mediating mechanism. While governments worldwide invest significantly in e-participation platforms, their economic impact remains unclear. Drawing on Sen’s capability approach and institutional economics, we position e-participation as a digital capability that enhances economic growth by positively impacting citizens’ instrumental freedoms. Using panel data analysis, including the fixed effects model, two-stage least squares regression, and dynamic panel threshold regression, we find that e-participation’s impact varies significantly across development contexts.

Low-income countries show strong positive effects through both direct and corruption-reduction channels, middle-income countries demonstrate moderate positive effects, while high-income countries exhibit diminishing returns. These findings challenge technological determinism by revealing the context-dependent nature of digital governance

interventions, emphasizing the need for tailored e-participation strategies across different development stages.

IIM Raipur & AIIMS Raipur Successfully Conducted a Medical Camp at Pontha Village

The Indian Institute of Management Raipur (IIM Raipur), in collaboration with the All-India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Raipur and Pranya's Foundation, successfully organized a medical camp at Pontha Village of Raipur February 19, 2025, With this initiative, essential healthcare services were provided in Orthopaedics, Medicine, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Dental, and Surgery concerns to the residents of Pontha and the neighbour villages of Cheriya and Banjari, benefitting about more than 500 villagers who were aged above 40 years.

With a large rural population facing challenges such as inaccessibility to quality healthcare, this camp featured a team of expert doctors from AIIMS Raipur who offered specialized support, creating a significant and positive impact on the health and well-being of the individuals in these underserved villages and ensuring holistic care for them.

Professor Ram Kumar Kakani, Director of IIM Raipur, shared, "One must realize that there is much need for intervention that has to come from institutes of higher education and academic excellence, such as IIM Raipur and AIIMS Raipur. Everyone must put their energies together, sensitize the community, and conduct health camps like this to help Chhattisgarh and institutions like IIM Raipur grow together."

Reflecting on the successful organization of the event, Dr. Pradeep Kumar Jekka, Deputy Nursing Superintendent at AIIMS Raipur, stated, "IIM Raipur has taken a good initiative conducting this health camp in coordination with Saksham Committee and AIIMS Raipur that has benefited individuals from the tribal areas." He commented on the plans, "Our main target is to cover Sickle Cell Disease that is more prevalent in these tribal areas. We also plan to conduct the blood donation camp and cover the child and paediatric group."

Expressing the village's appreciation for the initiative, Gaurav Sharma, Sarpanch of Pontha Village, said, "It is a good initiative to set up better health facilities in villages, and we don't have proper primary health care facilities around us, so in the future, if this can be improved, the number of medicines can be increased, and better service can be provided, it will help our fellow villagers who currently have to travel 10-20 km to private clinics and chambers for their health conditions."

A representative from Pranya's Foundation, Rahul Sharma, added, "We aim to establish a temporary or permanent medical centre in these villages in collaboration with AIIMS Raipur and IIM Raipur, which will be a proper support system for the surrounding 3-4 villages such that their health care related issues can be slowly mitigated."

This initiative underscores the power of collaboration in positively impacting society. Saksham Committee, IIM Raipur, AIIMS Raipur, and Pranya's Foundation remain highly committed to making quality healthcare more accessible and will continue their efforts to support underserved communities in the future.

Earlier, the Saksham committee of IIM Raipur, in collaboration with the Niine Foundation, had also successfully concluded a Menstrual Hygiene Awareness Camp in the schools of Kurru and Uparwara villages, Raipur that focused on raising awareness about menstrual health by encouraging open conversations for a more inclusive and informed society. Highlighting the importance of menstrual hygiene as a matter of education and empowerment, it helped in

educating young girls, challenging taboos, and driving meaningful change in rural and underprivileged communities.

रायपुर @ पत्रिका. भारतीय प्रबंध संस्थान (आईआईएम) ने पूर्णकालिक पीएचडी कार्यक्रम 2025 के लिए आवेदन प्रक्रिया शुरू करने की घोषणा की है। कार्यक्रम में शामिल होने के लिए आवेदन की अंतिम तिथि 10 मई 2025 निर्धारित की गई है। यह चार वर्षीय कार्यक्रम वित्त पोषित है।

कौन कर सकते हैं आवेदन?

पैसे उम्मीदवार आवेदन कर सकते हैं जिनके पास है, जीआरई, जे।एम.ए. (यूजीसी/सीएसआईआर), यूजीसी नेट स्कोर (1 जुलाई 2023 के बाद का) हो और जिन्होंने आईआईएम से परास्नातक/पीजीपी या समकक्ष (न्यूनतम 55 अंक) प्राप्त किया हो। इसके अलावा सीए/आईसीडब्ल्यूए और स्नातक डिग्री धारक, सीएस और बीकॉम (न्यूनतम 60% अंक), चार वर्षीय बीई/शेड्यूल/बीआरई (न्यूनतम 6.5 सीजीपीए) या पांच वर्षीय एकीकृत परास्नातक (न्यूनतम 60% अंक) प्राप्त करने वाले भी पात्र हैं।

अलावा, राष्ट्रीय और अंतरराष्ट्रीय सम्मेलनों के लिए 2 लाख की अनुदान राशि दी जाती है। वहीं आकस्मिक अनुदान और शोध संबंधित संसाधनों के लिए एक बार 50 हजार रुपये की सहायता भी दी जाएगी।
