

# IIM Raipur celebrates 14th Annual convocation

**RAIPUR:** The Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Raipur celebrated its 14th Annual Convocation, conferring degrees upon 595 students across its MBA, Executive MBA (E-MBA), and doctoral programs. Held at the institute's campus, the ceremony underscored IIM Raipur's commitment to #BuildingBusinessOwners, highlighting its strides in entrepreneurship, research, and executive education.

The convocation was graced by Chief Guest Ms. Prabha Narasimhan,



MD & CEO of Colgate Palmolive India Ltd., who addressed the graduating students with a powerful message on leadership, societal responsibility, and the importance of purpose-driven careers. This year, 216 students from the E-MBA program and 369 from the MBA programs received their degrees, including 344 from the 2023-25 batch and 25 from the MBA (ISE) 2022-24 batch. In addition,

9 doctoral degrees were awarded—7 from the FPM and 2 from the EFPM programs. The ceremony also recognized seven academic achievers with gold medals across MBA and E-MBA programs, including Shubham Kumar Singh, Sambhrant Dash, Banani Sarkar, and Sabitabrata Chatterjee.
