IIM Raipur Hosts First-Ever International Case Conference on Business Innovation



The Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Raipur announced its 1st International Case Conference (ICC 2026), scheduled for January 30–31, 2026, aimed at uniting researchers, practitioners, and policymakers worldwide. The conference will serve as a premier platform to explore evolving management practices, innovative pedagogy, and the future of business in emerging and global contexts. Participants are invited to submit original, unpublished teaching cases by December 31, 2025.

Prof. Sanjeev Prashar, Director-in-Charge and Conference Chief Patron, IIM Raipur, said that case pedagogy bridges theory and practice. Through the Case House (CHIRP), the institute aims to develop India-centric cases with global relevance. The First Case Conference continues this mission by bringing together academicians, researchers, and practitioners to co-create knowledge and foster collaboration. By focusing on themes like strategy, sustainability, entrepreneurship, and digital transformation, IIM Raipur seeks to build a strong repository of Indian cases and drive innovation in management education.

Aligned with IIM Raipur’s vision of “Building Business Owners,” ICC 2026 will feature a Special Issue Publication of selected high-quality cases and promote global academic–industry partnerships. The conference will focus on three major themes: Contemporary Business Practices, Integration of AI in Business, and Globalising Indian Business Strategy.

Key highlights include workshops on case writing and teaching, thematic tracks on AI, sustainability, and pedagogy innovation, and Best-Case Awards recognizing excellence. Selected cases will be

considered for publication in Emerging Markets Case Studies (Emerald Publishing). Additionally, a Mini-Case Competition for students will encourage experiential learning. ICC 2026 aims to strengthen case-based pedagogy, enhance international exposure for Indian scholarship, and shape responsible future business leaders.

IIM Raipur observes Hindi Pakhwada 2025



The Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Raipur observed 'Hindi Pakhwada' from September 15th to 30th to promote the use of the Hindi language. The celebration featured a Hindi poetry competition and a plantation drive, both witnessing enthusiastic participation from students and staff. The closing ceremony was graced by Chief Guest Shri Varun Sakhaji Srivastava, Associate Editor at IBC24 and writer, along with Prof. Sanjeev Prashar, Director-in-Charge, Prof. Jagrook Dawra, and Prof. Damini Saini.



In his address, Shri Srivastava highlighted that every Indian language has its own significance, and that promoting Hindi should not diminish others. He described language as a reflection of community values and praised Hindi for its flexibility and inclusive nature. Emphasizing the cultural richness of India's linguistic diversity, he urged greater intellectual research in Hindi to preserve its originality and authenticity, concluding that pride in one's mother tongue fosters unity, respect, and meaningful

dialogue.

Prof. Sanjeev Prashar, Director-in-Charge of IIM Raipur, stated that Hindi is not just a language but a powerful symbol of India's cultural identity, unity, and national integration. Marking 76 years since Hindi was recognized as one of the Rajbhashas in 1949, he said the language reflects India's traditions and heritage. In a diverse nation, Hindi acts as a *Setu* (bridge), connecting regions while strengthening all languages. He emphasized that institutions like IIMs play a vital role in promoting Hindi as a language of knowledge, research, and administration. Hindi Pakhwada, he noted, is a shared responsibility to celebrate and expand Hindi with pride.

In his opening address, Prof. Jagrook Dawra echoed the sentiments of Union Minister for Education Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, emphasizing the cultural and constitutional significance of Hindi. Recalling its adoption as an official language on 14th September 1949, he remarked that Hindi is not only a language but also a reflection of India's cultural richness and unity.

IIM Raipur Shows Consistent Growth in NIRF 2025 Rankings (15th Position)

The Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Raipur proudly announced its strong performance in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2025, released on September 4, 2025.

Building on last year’s progress, the institute achieved growth across teaching, research, and outreach, reaffirming its commitment to academic excellence and societal contribution.

In 2025, IIM Raipur expanded its faculty strength from 58 to 63, enhancing research and teaching capabilities. The PG admissions also rose from 580 to 713, reflecting a more diverse student community. Consultancy projects grew from 4 to 10, with earnings increasing to ₹2.98 crore, signifying stronger industry engagement. Similarly, revenues from executive and management development programs climbed to ₹26.53 crore, indicating rising corporate demand. Investment in academic infrastructure also grew substantially, with library and capital expenditure increasing from ₹2.75 crore to ₹7.06 crore. Doctoral output strengthened, with 11 PhD graduates in 2023–24 compared to just two previously.

Prof. Sanjeev Prashar, Director-in-Charge, credited the success to the institute’s focused efforts in research and academic innovation, while Prof. Satyasiba Das, Dean (External Relations), emphasized growing corporate collaboration. Moving forward, IIM Raipur remains dedicated to fostering impactful research, innovative pedagogy, and stronger engagement with industry and society.

IIM Raipur Launched 7 Future-Focused MDPs on AI, Design Thinking & Leadership

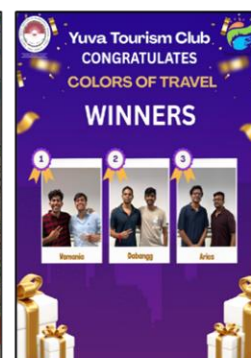
Product Mania

The O.P. Jindal Engineering & Management Scholarships (OPJEMS) 2025 was successfully conducted at IIM Raipur, launching on 7th August 2025 under the O.P. Jindal Group. The program aimed to recognize students excelling in academics, leadership, and innovation in engineering and management. Participants underwent multiple stages, beginning with registration and business proposal submissions, followed by an online aptitude test on 18th–19th September. Shortlisted candidates then appeared for online interviews from 13th–17th October, presenting their ideas and demonstrating analytical and managerial skills. Results were declared on 31st October 2025. The scholarships—INR 80,000 for engineering and INR 1,50,000 for management scholars—rewarded merit and encouraged leadership. The initiative provided students with exposure to real-world problem-solving and strategic thinking, garnering enthusiastic participation and appreciation from the IIM Raipur community.

Shri. L. R. Mundra Memorial Scholarship 2025

The Sh. L. R. Mundra Memorial Scholarship 2025, instituted by the Saini Charitable Education Trust, Ropar, was successfully conducted at IIM Raipur, coordinated by the Student Affairs Committee. Aimed at supporting higher education, the scholarship provides financial aid to deserving students—especially from the Saini community—pursuing Master’s, Doctoral, or Post-Doctoral programs in fields like science, technology, commerce, management, and mass media. Applicants under 35 from Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Delhi, or Chandigarh submitted online forms with academic records and recommendations. Shortlisted candidates attended interviews, and selected students received up to ₹25,000 per month, fostering academic excellence and enabling equitable access to education while nurturing future leaders.

IIM Raipur launches JAP-2026; single admission process for 4 IIMs

TO REDUCE the burden of students, in a strategic move to streamline MBA admissions and enhance collaboration, the Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) in Kashipur, Raipur, Ranchi, and Tiruchirappalli have jointly launched the Joint Admission Process (JAP) 2026. The initiative will be coordinated by IIM Raipur, and it will conduct a unified selection process in these four IIMs after the announcement of CAT-2025 results, which is scheduled to

take place across the nation and foreign countries on November 30. On the basis of CAT-2025 scores, IIM Raipur will conduct JAP 2026 and select students for MBA programmes in IIM Raipur, IIM Ranchi, IIM Kashipur, and IIM Tiruchirappalli.

This move is aimed at reducing the administrative burden on candidates and institutions, while ensuring a standardised, transparent, and aspirant-centric admission experience.

The participating IIMs described JAP 2026 as a joint initiative "showing commitment to excellence, collaborative

resource management, and delivering a transparent, aspirant-focused admission experience that meets IIM standards.

Aspirants of CAT-2025 have welcomed this initiative of JAP-2026 by four IIMs of the country, including IIM Raipur. After so much hard work, struggle, and expense to clear the CAT exam, the admission process at IIMs becomes even more expensive than the exam. Many students are not in a good enough position to travel to IIMs in different states to get admission into MBA programmes in any branch.

"In JAP-2026, we will be able
